What is Recreation Therapy?

Recreation Therapy is a process that utilizes functional intervention, education, and recreation participation to enable individuals with any physical, cognitive, emotional or social limitations to acquire or maintain the skills, knowledge and behaviors that allow them to function independently with the least possible amount of assistance, achieve an optimal leisure experience, and participate as fully as possible in society.

What does Recreation Therapy at Spectrum look like?

Spectrum's team of Certified Recreation Therapy Specialists (CTRS) help our clients develop skills needed to enhance independence in the community, while participating in recreational activities that improve social interaction with others. Our CTRS' work one on one with clients in the community and when possible, Spectrum arranges group activities among age and skill appropriate clients to share in recreational and social experiences. A recreation therapy session can include virtually any activity, but some of the most common activities are: hiking, geocaching, camping, miniature golf, slacklining, biking, kayaking, swimming, physical fitness, team sports, and more! In addition, Spectrum also offers Recreation Outing Groups on scheduled Saturdays throughout each semester.
